The Tarpon 26 and Cuda 23 — both classically styled with utilitarian features, including a full transom — are masterfully designed yet simple with a yacht finish. The term “hybrid” describes the cross between a bay boat and an offshore design. Andros engineered its boats to handle rough water and chop without hesitation while maintaining a smooth, very dry ride, making them truly versatile. With a single 250 hp outboard, the Tarpon 26 features a top speed of 55 mph and cruises at 34 mph.

Designed and styled by one of the world's top yacht-design firms, Andros boats fish and play hard. The list of standard features and premium finishes runs long. A specialized hydraulic jack plate allows for 21 inches of vertical travel. The lighted, 40-gallon livewell sports a clear lid etched with the Andros logo. Two 7-foot, insulated and lockable rod boxes can readily

double as additional fish boxes. The expansive anchor locker makes access and retrieval of ground tackle a breeze.

Choose from several dual-station-tower, hardtop and T-top options. The hulls — foam-filled for safety — boast other desirable features, including large, color-matched swim platforms, top-of-the-line yacht hardware, a large casting deck with storage beneath, as well as cushion packages and bow enclosures for family

cruising. SeaStar hydraulic steering comes standard on all models, and Andros offers optional drive-by-wire controls as well.

Andros' impeccable attention to detail, from custom nonskid surfaces to individually wrapped and sealed wiring, is clearly visible throughout. Every boat comes with a custom switch panel and individual breakers. A large electronics box built into the console allows equipment to be flush-mounted.
