Bluefin USA Edge Series

Bluefin USA, a manufacturer of advanced-technology saltwater tackle, introduces a new series of high-quality spinning reels designed to exceed your expectations regarding technology, performance and aesthetics. Bluefin's Edge Series spinning reels include the Edge GC 4000, Edge GC 5000, Edge Lite GS 7000 and Edge Lite GS 8000. All four spinners boast the highest-grade ball bearings, gears made of surgical stainless steel, ample line capacities, extremely smooth drags and an elegant finish.

When crafting the smaller versions of our spinning reels, the Edge GC 4000 and 5000, we include the following features: body, cover and rotor constructed of high-strength aluminum; one-way anti-reverse clutch bearing; a total of six stainless-steel ball bearings; Bluefin's S-stroke system, which assures perfect line lay for improved casting performance; anti-twist line roller for worry-free line management; high-strength, large-diameter aluminum bail; solid, high-strength drive gear that is

corrosion-resistant; and last but not least, an aluminum handle (interchangeable for left- or right-hand retrieve) topped with our advanced, soft-rubber grip.

The Bluefin GC Series is light, well balanced and boasts plenty of power in a small package.

As for line capacities, the GC 4000 holds 300 yards of 8-pound monofilament or 190 yards of 12-pound. The reel holds 300 yards of 15-pound braided line or 180 yards of 30-pound. It gathers line quickly with a 5.5-to-1 gear ratio. The larger GC 5000 (5.5-to-1 gear ratio) has room on the spool for 500 yards of 8-pound or 240 yards of 14-pound monofilament. Anglers who use braid can pack on 500 yards of 15-pound or 300 yards of 30-pound.

The Edge Lite Series is for those who prefer graphite.

The GS 7000 and GS 8000 (4.5-to-1 gear ratio) have proven themselves as the ideal lightweight graphite reels to keep in your tackle lineup. The body, side plate and rotor are all made of high-strength graphite.

A total of four top-grade stainless-steel ball bearings assure smooth operation, while the S-stroke system and anti-twist line roller combine for perfect line control and long casts. The reels' internal structure receives several coats of a high-quality, corrosion-proof material to provide multilayered protection from salt water.

The handle shaft allows for quick changes between left- and right-handed operation, and the ergonomically designed grip makes it comfortable when cranking hard and fast against stubborn fish. Generous line capacities set these reels apart from others. The GS 7000 holds 420 yards of 12-pound mono or 280 yards of 30-pound-test. Braid capacities equal 600 yards of 30-pound and 440 yards of 50-pound line.

All models come with a cover that protects the reel when on the rod. At last, you get the fish-fighting quality and dependability you've always wanted in a spinning reel at an affordable price. Get the "Edge" you need to tackle any fish — from Bluefin USA's Advanced Technology Gear.
