Carolina Classic 25

Carolina Classic designed this 25-footer for the angler who wants a capable offshore boat that he can trailer and launch near his favorite fishing grounds. It's an exciting offshore, all-weather fishing boat that delivers all its name promises: the distinctive flared bow; amidships power for fast performance and ideal balance in heavy seas; a spacious flush-deck cockpit; and long-range fuel capacity. Wet and fully rigged, she delivers speeds in excess of 45 mph! And an owner can choose a variety of fuel-stingy gas or diesel inboard power options.

Like all Carolina Classics, this boat comes rigged with all the top-of-the-line components and hardware that serious fishermen prefer. The self-bailing cockpit has high gunwales and recessed hawse pipes, rod holders, freshwater and raw-water wash-downs, and a livewell that doubles as a fish box. The cockpit also features a stand-up tackle-rigging station that you can use as extra seating. Forward, the full-sized cuddy sports a V-berth, secure rod storage and an electric head.

Many consider the 25's engine compartment a work of art; it's large enough to fit big-block engine options, with plenty of room remaining to work around all four sides of the engines. All the components are neatly organized and logically located. There's thick insulation to reduce sound



when she's running. And because the air intakes are high above the sheer, the engine room stays clear of chocking salt air. Access is simple — with the touch of a switch, the entire helm deck raises and stays open, even in rolling seas.

No question, she's for big-time fishing. And you can pull her behind your truck.

Carolina Classic 28

This rugged, redesigned convertible represents the very heart of the Carolina Classic fleet of sport-fishers for serious offshore anglers. When running in big water, it's hard to believe she's only 28 feet, but that she is, keeping up with the big boys with ease nonetheless. This 28's cockpit, one of the largest in its class, makes most 40-footers envious. The 28 runs fast and dry, has plenty of working room and includes more than ample

storage, fish boxes and a livewell.

It provides plenty of living room too. The big cabin has 6 feet of headroom. This completely comfortable space includes a roomy V-berth with filler, a galley with microwave, a sink, refrigerator and removable dinette table, as well as a full walk-in head complete with an electric toilet and a shower. You'll be impressed by the many



storage areas, including secure rod holders, that keep everyone happy on those weekend excursions.

Sizable and fully functional, this 28-foot model comes from the factory as a very complete package: The list of "extras" is very short, with the most popular add-on consistently being the tower, which encloses the lower helm deck while providing a complete second station above. Its rugged, all-welded aluminum construction sports plenty of rocket launchers and Lee Pro Outriggers.

Fast, rugged and easy-to-maintain. That's the hallmark of all Carolina Classic offshore fishing boats.
