### Jupiter 34 Forward Seating

Jupiter's 34 Forward Seating integrates the best features of the company's existing models with new enhancements and features. Filling the gap between the classic 31 and the flagship 38, Jupiter engineered the new 34 specifically to accommodate Yamaha's new fuel-efficient 350 hp, V-8 four-stroke outboard engines. The 34 works equally well for small-boat owners moving up and for owners of larger boats who want to fish and cruise without needing a captain and crew.

The 34's Euro-style motor well accommodates both twin- and triple-outboard installations. With twin 350 hp outboards, the boat tops out at about 60 mph. Cruising speed ranges from about 35 to 40 mph.

The unique, posi-stern pad on the deep-V hull's bottom allows the 34 to achieve a dynamic balance, providing a level, stable, soft and dry ride. This design also allows the hull to lift onto plane without much bow rise, which often causes loss of visibility at the helm.

The 10-foot, 5-inch beam, centerline fuel tanks and ample freeboard aft make this an extremely stable and comfortable boat. No wonder Jupiter uses "out of this world performance" as its motto.

This well-thought-out machine includes some other interesting and unique fishing features. A 45-gallon livewell rounds out the standard prep center, giving anglers more fishing room in the cockpit. The prep center also includes a freshwater sink, tackle drawers and a trash bin.

Standard helm seating includes a cushioned leaning post and backrest. Optional helm and companion chairs are also available. The versatile forward-seating arrangement is equally adept for tournament fishing and family cruising.

The 34's large console offers ample space for flush-mounted electronics and opens to a head compartment with standard rod racks, dry-storage locker, freshwater sink and shower, and room for an optional electric head. At the transom, an optional foldaway stern seat tucks completely out of the way when not in use.

Seven insulated deck compartments include two 104-gallon, macerated fish boxes, two 11-cubic-foot storage boxes, one 13-cubic-foot compartment forward of the console and two large overboard draining boxes under the forward seating area. All hatches come gasketed and dogged. Port and starboard side lockers offer dedicated storage for lifejackets and safety gear. The bow area can also accommodate an optional windlass with anchor.

The Jupiter 34 was designed by avid boaters for avid boaters and anglers. Jupiter Marine builds a limited number of boats every year, and each is carefully crafted.
