Regulator 34 SS Center Console

Known for building the finest offshore center-console fishing boats, Regulator introduced the all-new 34 SS Starboard Seating Center Console at the Fort Lauderdale International Boat Show.

The Regulator 34 SS sports an abundance of innovative standards like gigantic wraparound starboard seating (SS) — the first of its kind for Regulator — with massive storage room for rods up to seven feet in length. It's equipped with an amply sized lockable console and room for up to two 12-inch multifunction displays. The single-level cockpit is enormous, uncluttered and strategically outfitted for the blue-water fisherman. Tandem Garelick seats hide a 40-gallon livewell and provide the ultimate comfort when heading offshore. This angling machine is also equipped with a massive 340-quart transom fish box with an option for refrigeration.

Other sure-to-please features include an all-fiberglass, stand-up head, a compact galley with an optional microwave oven and refrigerator, and a berth that extends forward for sleeping or storage. Other enhancements include a frameless glass windshield and Lenco® trim tabs. A quad-battery electrical system and Yamaha Command Link instrumentation round out a truly impressive equipment list for this new model.

“Our new 34 SS Center Console represents a revolution in offshore fishing, sporting the legendary soft, dry ride for

which Regulator is famous, with extra comfort and all the functionality of a larger center console,” says Joan Maxwell, president of Regulator. “Customers who live to fish offshore one day and cruise the Intracoastal the next will not be disappointed.”

The Regulator 34 SS Center Console was designed by renowned naval architect Lou Codega, who was responsible for Regulator's inaugural launch in the market with its 26 Classic. Like its predecessors, the 34 SS Center Console retains its stalwart Regulator heritage. It is built tough with Regulator's unmatched construction techniques and exclusive Fiberglass Grillage System, enabling it to stand up to the most punishing offshore conditions while

delivering a smooth, dry, comfortable ride.

According to Maxwell, this new model is unique by virtue of its advantages. “It's a true 34 sport-fishing boat with an exceptionally large cockpit, the largest in its class, and boasts all the fishing features a dedicated angler would want,” says Maxwell. “Utilization of the engine bracket allowed the designers to take back the transom. Since the motor mounts are pushed back, you maximize precious deck space, plus the brackets deliver less resistance in the water, so you can get to where you're going faster. These design elements truly give Regulator an edge in this niche.”

The Regulator 34 SS is powered by twin Yamaha V-8, F350 outboard engines. These four-stroke motors utilize power steering and electronic controls, which make them highly maneuverable for their size and the ideal power plant for the new center console.

Regulator's line of 23- to 34-foot offshore sport-fishing boats is highly recognized for quality craftsmanship and rugged durability. The company is a repeat recipient of the National Marine Manufacturers Association's Marine Industry CSI Award for customer satisfaction in the “Fiberglass Outboard Boats” category.
